**Announcement for the 2011 Michael Prize**

The MICHAEL PRIZE was awarded for the first time in 1963 to stimulate epilepsy research in Germany; it is now one of the most highly regarded international awards for the best contribution to scientific and to clinical research which promote further development in epileptology.

The MICHAEL PRIZE is awarded biennially and specially designed to attract younger scientists ( normally not older than 45 years of age).

**The prize fund is EUROS 20.000**

For the MICHAEL PRIZE 2011, up to a maximum of three papers in English language may be considered, at least one of which – published or not yet published – must be from the period 2009 / 2010. The papers, together with a curriculum vitae, should be submitted by electronic mail to STIFTUNG MICHAEL before **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010**.
